Disaster Risk Reduction programme was a continuation programme in 10 most vulnerable villages of Kanas block in Puri district as pilot basis.

Similarly, Providing Access to safe Drinking water in water quality hit flood prone 15 villages of Kanas, Satyabadi and Brahmagiri block in Puri district to provide safe drinking water year the round was an innovative project under Water, sanitation and hygiene promotion- WASH.

Priority paid to smooth organization of 40 nos of Multipurpose cyclone/flood Shelter level mock drill with the support of Govt. of Odisha in 5 blocks (Gop, Nimapada, Satyabadi, Delang and Kanas) for mass awareness on Disaster preparedness. Shelter level committees/Task Forces/Apadamitra/PRI members/ASHA/AWW, academicians and other community stakeholders took part in the programmes.

Besides, important week/Days were observed to create awareness among the people on Odisha Disaster Preparedness Day and National Day for Disaster Risk Reduction, World Health Day, World Environment Day as well as Leprosy Eradication Programme..

Brief Annual Report in respect of Society for Leprosy Amelioration and Rehabilitation (SOLAR) for the year 2021-22

Introduction:-

Disaster is the biggest cause of Human distress- Across the world. Puri district of Odisha is one of the most Disaster prone areas in India in form of cyclone, flood, Water logging. Considering the reality of growing Disaster Risk specially, livelihood, health care and available of safe drinking water in most vulnerable pockets. Society for Leprosy Amelioration & Rehabilitation (SOLAR) have continued on going Disaster Risk Reduction, access to providing safe Drinking water and allied issues. Following are the brief activities carried out during the financial year 2021-22

A. Humanitarian Response Programme:

A.1- COVID-19 Pandemic Response:-

Since there were not available of vaccine/Drug to cure COVID-19affected people, SOLAR took awareness programme on prevention measures. To follow Govt. protocol as well as maintain social distancing, use of mask, Hand washing and try to stay home in the project area and other part of the district with the support of network in Puri district.

B. Disaster Risk Reduction:-

Since community is the first responders to disaster, initiative was taken to strengthening community and community level institutions through Disaster Risk Reduction Programme.

B-1.Updating of 10 nos, Viage level Disaster Management Plan (VDMP):-

The village level Disaster Management Plan (VDMP) is the mirror of area villages from which it can early assess the Hazard zone, vulnerability and other socio-economic and cultural status of the concerned villages. So, 10 nos. village levels VDMC in the most vulnerable pockets of Kanas block in Puri district.

1. Formation of WASH Committees, Strengthening of Gram Kalyan samitis and developing WASH Plans:

In order to identify the appropriate drinking water sources and smooth implementation of the low cost flood resistant community managed solar energized Iron removal plants, Village WASH Committee were formed with active involvement of the VDMC/TF/Apadamitra/SHG/CBOs in the concerned 15 nos. villages. Village level institutions like Gram Kalyan Samiti, youth club, women self help groups, AWW, ASHA were oriented on the project.

2. Installation of Iron removal Plants with solar based energy source:- There were 15 nos of Iron Removal Plants with solar based energy source were installed in the venerable sides of project areas. Now the plants are provides safe drinking water and looking after day to day maintenance are collaborates. The above 15 nos of IRP which started in 2020 was completed in in 2022 reporting period. The detailed location of IRP with support of solar energy are given below:-

4. Testing of Water Sources in a regular basis-

Water testing of 15 Identified sources has been completed in the last quarter with the support of community members and SEM of the concerned Grampanchayat under RWS&S department. All Tests has been done in the laboratory of RWS&S department in Puri district.

5. Chlorine dosing for selected units

The Chlorine dosing system have installed in Iron Removal Plants of 6 selected villages like Sanaora, Dakhnikera, Golar, Karamala School, Nuapada & Malisahi in the project villages of Kanas, Satyabadi & Brahmagiri blocks of Puri district as more bacteria free sources in integrated manner.

6. WASH Tool kits & spare parts for repairing & Maintenance of Water sources

Tool kits is the Key components under Livpure project and it is Very much useful during disaster warning and used in normal time to repaired the Iron removal Plants by the Skilled volunteers, WASH Committee members and concerned SEM. In the last phase of the Project period we have been handed over 15nos of Tool kits & spare parts to the Concerned WASH committees.

7. Handover of IRPs to Community in a function

The Iron removal plants Powered by solar energy are handed over to the village committee as well as WASH Committee members in a Public Meeting held on 29th March 2022 at Dakhnikera village of Satyabadi Block of Puri district. In this Occasion Sri Akshya Kumar Biswal, Regional Manager of Oxfam India, Odisha, Deputy Collector Emergency, Puri Sri Jintendra Kumar Patra, Chairperson of Satyabadi block, Sri Sunil Kumar Panda, Block Development Officer, Khirod Kumar Behera, Representative of OSDMA-cum- Emergency section Puri, DPO, Sukanta Das, Sukala Sarpanch, Lalita Mohan Senapati, PS Member of sukala Gp Basanta Kumar Biswal, Zilla Parisad Member Narayan Routray, Sarpanch Manjulata Nayak, Bindhan GP, Kanas Block & EX-Sarpanch Sabita Mohapatra, Talamala GP of Brahmagiri Block, Harish Chandra Dash, Secretary SOLAR we are attended the Handed over Function as a Guest of Honor as well as all dignitaries were presented their opinion, Suggestions best on Iron Removal Plants and its impacts to the community in coming days.

During the function the invited delegates were handed over the Handing over documents to the 15nos of WASH Committee representatives. The chairman of Satyabadi Panchyat Samiti, Members of Zila Parisada, Sarpanchs and Govt. Officials were highly appreciated the programme. They also assured to scale up the similar model at their end.

8. District level consultation with Govt. & other stakeholders

District level consultation with Govt. & other stakeholders held at Youth Hostel, Puri on 25th March 2022. There were 50 participants from the different Govt. Officials, PRIs, NGOs, Media Representatives, Village community leaders participated in this meeting. The Objective of the Meeting was Providing Access to safe drinking water through installation of Iron Removal Plants Powered by solar energy and focused the impact of Iron Removal Plants as well as prior to replicate of this model towards convergence Govt. resources from the Panchayat fund and RWS&S department.

In this Occasion Sunil Kumar Panda, Chairperson of Satyabadi Panchayat samity, Assistant Director of Agriculture Nabakisor Mohapatra, Asutosa Das, OSDMA, Puri, Harishchandra Dash, Secretary, SOLAR, Bhagirathi Nayak, NGO representative SMRC, Bhubaneswar & Jaganatha Bastia, Media forum, Puri were attended as a Guest of Honor and recommended their suggestions to popularized the model and do the advocacy at various level for its replication. The utility of the Iron Removal Plants and getting the Iron free safe drinking water presented the views of concerned village Committee members those were participated in the meeting. Secondly, a district level net work namely "Safe drinking water campaign" (SDWC) was formed to monitor and facilitate the drinking water facilities in the Block and District.

9. Orientation training of PRI members

Orientation Training of PRI Members and other stakeholders were organized at Kusumbenti GP Office of Brahmagiri Block of Puri District on 26th March 2022. There were 60nos of representatives from ASHA, AWW, Village Volunteers, PRIs, WASH Committee members and GP level Govt Officials were participated in this training. During this training discussion were highlighted Iron content issues in drinking water and its technical Issues as well as low cost model on Iron Removal Plant with solar energy. Representatives were put forth their interest and suggested to integrate the Iron removal Plants under GPDP plan. The representatives were happy and grateful to local NGO SOLAR, Oxfam India & Livpure foundation for doing the best model of Iron removal Plants installed at their area to providing access to Iron free safe drinking water

10. Facilitation of Interface meeting with Panchayat and Govt. Administration:

In order to strengthen the coordination among Block and Panchayat level Govt. Officials in 4 nos of Facilitation of Interface meeting with the different stakeholders of the PRIs, Community, Govt., WASH Committee members were held at Golara,

Kanas on 14.06.2021, Talakokala, Brahmagiri on 20.6.2021, Apiti, Brahmagiri on 18.9.2021 and Behera sahi, Karamala, Kanas on 26.10.2021. In this meeting PRI members & community shared the gaps between the Govt. Policy and Action Programme. Secondly, they also shared to submit their proposed action plan timely in the Block level Officials to replicate Iron Removal Plants from the Govt. funds under Gramapanchayat Development funds.

The following points were emerged from the discussed such as

- To strengthen the coordination of PRI members and Block level Govt Officials.
- Plan to mobilize more Govt. Funds in the Health and water safety measure and Sanitation.
- More orientation to WASH Committee, SEM and AWW, ASHA on safe drinking water management.

11. IEC & Wall paintings

IEC activities were carried out in the 15 project villages. Information relating to the use and maintenance of IRP was written down in eye catching covered surface of Iron Removal Plants and its impact.

12. Impact of the Project

- Plan to integrate Iron Removal Plants through PRIs & Govt. officials in GPDP. Community and WASH committee members owned the IRP models.
- Village community and nearby villagers are getting the Iron free safe drinking water in Kanas, Brhamagiri & Satyabadi blocks of Puri district.

D. Government sponsored Programme:-

The coastal district of with 150 KM of coast line is prone to Natural calamities in term of Cyclone, Flood, Tsunami & others. Keeping in view SOLAR Family is regularly carryout Community Based Disaster Preparedness awareness programme such as Meeting, Rally, Training, Mock drill and individual/Group interaction.

D.1- Mock Drill:-

With the support of District Administration, Puri and OSDMA. On 19th June 2020, SOLAR organized 40nos. Mock Drill in 5 blocks of Puri district such as Gop, Nimapada, Satyabadi, Delang & Kanas with the active support of Multipurpose Flood/Cyclone Shelter Maintenance Committees, Apadamitra, Task force & Community concerned. The programme was carried out with strictly followed up the COVID-19 guidelines & protocol.

D.2- Preparation of Village Disaster Management Plan (VDMP):-

With the support of District administration, Puri as well as OSDMA, Bhubaneswar. SOLAR has taken assignment to complete 40nos. of Village Disaster Management Plan (VDMP). Owing to COVID-19 pandemic, the work was not full progress. However out of 40 SOLAR has completed 25nos of VDMP. The VDMP was prepared at village level after interaction with the community, Village leader/ Taskforce, village education committee, ASHA/AWW/PRI, Sarapancha, Panchayat Samiti member & other stake holders. During preparation of VDMP people mobilized to prepare the village Social Map, Resource Map & Hazard Map as well as collection of data. One /two orientations meetings on preparation of VDMP was organized for understanding & preparation.

E. Livelihood:-

E.1:- Livelihood opportunities for People with Disabilities (PWD) and Caregivers:-

Livelihood is a major problem in the Disaster prone area like Kanas, Brahmagiri, Gop, Astaranga, Krushnaprasad, Delang of Puri District. The situation is more critical the families having PWD/Independent women. Keeping in view 15 PWDs Self Help Groups consisting more than 620 members were engaged in production of Candle, Coir-Doormats, Doll making. All the PWD SHG members have developed good relationship with the Govt. for mobilization of resources and Marketing.

E.2- Milk Society:-

The milk society which was started in Talamalasaahi, Brahmagiri block, Dist Puri is a road model in the block. There were 40 families are getting Livelihood facilities from this unit. Looking at this unit other women Self Help Groups are starting Milk Society in the block.

F.- Miscellaneous:-

F.1-In order to more available to the Govt. Niramaya Yojana, SOLAR Family Organize inter action /Group discussion/ meeting for Community awareness so that people shall aware and avail the benefit of Niramaya Yojana.

F.3- Observance of Odisha Disaster Preparedness Day and National Day for Disaster Reduction Day -29th October 2021:-

In order to create awareness on Disaster Risk Reduction measures SOLAR Observed the Odisha Disaster Preparedness Day and National Day for Disaster

Reduction Day 29th October 2021 following of COVID-19 guidelines & protocols. The programme was organized in the project area of Kanas block in form of a meeting. Nearly 30-35 participants took part in the programme. All participants were used Mask-social distancing and other protocols.

F.4-Observance of Anti-Leprosy week on 30th Jan-5thFeb.- 2022:-

As previous year SOLAR Observed the Anti-Leprosy week such as meeting, Case detection, case follow up mass awareness, leaflet, posters on discards were used in the meeting and personal contact of Patients. How people take facilities of M.D.T. was emphasis. The week long 30th January to 5th February-2022 programme inaugurated at Konark Abdhut Matha.

F.5- Case studies, Best Practice Notes, Reports:-

In order to study the impact of the work and awareness of the community SOLAR regularly collecting good case studies best practice note for documents and publish them to others changes.

F.6- Opening of Community Information Centre:-

As part of the resources mobilization as liasioning with Govt. for benefit of poor people. SOLAR has opened 5 community information centers in project area. Planning is also designing to open more centre in Cyclone Shelter/Flood shelters.

F.7-Awareness on Falaria disease:-

Owing to the arise of the Falaria disease in some pocket in the Puri district SOLAR organized awareness campaign in the different places inviting resources persons from the hospitals.

G.1 - Monitoring and Evaluation:

Periodical monitoring being organized by programme coordinator and management. The regular monthly staff review and planning meeting were organized to overcome the gaps and reduce the risk and challenges as well as to provide feedback to the staff. Besides, resource support agencies such as OXFAM India, Govt. of Odisha and others monitor programme activities time to time.

G.2- Periodically meeting of General Body as well as Governing Committee:

As previous years SOLAR regularly organing its Governing Committee and General Body, regularly.

H. – Puri District Disaster Mitigation Forum (PDDMF):

SOLAR is also convener of Puri district Disaster Mitigation Forum, which is working in the 11 blocks of Puri district to deal with Disaster Risk Reduction programme.
